ENROLLMENT PROCESS

1. All new students must complete an Enrollment Application and send it with the \$50 enrollment fee to the above address before registering for courses. (Enrollment fee is non-refundable and only enrolls student in the school and does not include individual course tuition fees.)
2. Upon receipt of application and acceptance into the school, registration information will be sent to the student.
3. Submit registration form, tuition and textbook (if purchased from school) payments for desired course. **Registrations must be RECEIVED at the district office by the stated monthly deadline or they will be returned.**
4. Study materials and textbook (if purchased from school) will be mailed.

DISCLAIMERS AND AGREEMENTS

- Courses completed through the Appalachian District School of Ministry (AD-SOM) that are required by the Assemblies of God for credentials meet the *educational requirements* of the General Council for the respective level of credential.
